Now that I have been tested, what comes next?

Go home and isolate yourself as much as possible.

Until your test results come back, our clinical team will call you each day to check on you and follow up on your symptoms.

If at any time you develop severe shortness of breath, go to the Emergency Center.

Once your test results come back, we will contact you with those results.

If your results are negative we will provide you with advice on remaining virus free.

If you have a positive result, a Health Care provider will contact you with care instructions and we will continue to follow up with you daily by phone for 14 days from the date of your test.



Stay home from work, school, and away from other public places. If you must go out, avoid using any kind of public transportation, ridesharing or taxis.



Cover your coughs and sneezes.



Wash your hands often with soap and water for at least 20 seconds or clean your hands with an alcohol-based hand sanitizer that contains at least 60% alcohol.



As much as possible, **stay** in a specific room and **away from other people** in your home. Also, you should use a separate bathroom if available. If you need to be around other people in or outside of the home, wear a facemask.
